1. *What do the Gold Day students do on the first day?*

Nothing--there first day will be September 9.

2. *What happens if we have a scheduled, calendar day off (e.g. Columbus Day holiday)?*

The schedule adjusts forward--If Friday was a Maroon Day, Tuesday will be a Gold Day

3. *What happens if we have an unexpected school closure (e.g. School needs to close for a day due to staff absences, weather, etc.)?*

School day will be held remotely, with students in the designated cohort checking in at scheduled times with teachers for lessons and instructions for independent work.

4. *Will that be synchronous?*

Yes. Teachers will meet with their classes and take attendance during the normally scheduled time for class.

5. *Does the class need to meet for the entire 90 minutes?*

Yes. There does not need to be a live meeting for the entire time, but students are expected to have 90 minutes of work to complete. Teachers should be available during the class time to answer questions and provide support.

6. *What happens if the school is closed for a longer period?*

We will continue remotely with the hybrid model unless a district change in the remote learning schedule is announced.

7. *What are my students doing on their independent days? Am I posting new lessons?*

The independent work should be assigned during the live class meeting--the normal process for most teachers in our traditional modified block schedule. Certainly put the work on Google Classroom, but should not be scheduling a new post on the independent work days. Work would typically be due for the next class meeting.

8. *Speaking of handing in work, will there be deadlines this year?*

Yes! We will be implementing a late-work protocol for the 2020-2021 school year.
