



Alvirne High School Student/Parent Safety & Logistics Plan

As part of the Hudson School District we believe that...

- The safety and well-being of our students and staff is our highest priority.
- Schools serve numerous, important roles in a community and it is our responsibility to support our students.

As such, Alvirne will be implementing the following guidelines throughout the school day. It is expected that all members of our school community will work together to keep everyone safe and healthy. Be aware that this document is fluid and we will communicate changes as needed.

Pre-Arrival:

- **Self-check at home--if a student has any symptoms or a temperature above 100.4, he/she must stay home.**
- If you have traveled out of New England, please follow travel guidelines per “NH Stay at Home Guidelines” <https://www.covidguidance.nh.gov/out-state-visitors>.

Transportation to School:

- All students will wear masks upon entry to the bus.
- Buses will load from back to front with assigned seating.
- Siblings will share a seat; no more than two students to a seat.
- Buses will unload from front to back.
- Eligible students* may obtain parking permits from the Main Office.
 - **Any* licensed student with a properly insured & registered vehicle may apply for a permit; cost is reduced to \$10 this year.
- Students will park in the large, main parking lot.
- The parking lot and student cars are off limits during the school day.

Building Arrival:

- All students ***must*** wear masks in the building except at designated mask break times.
- Students may enter the building from the following doors until 7:25: the current teacher entrance door, the elevator door, the main entrance doors, and the new CTE entrance when ready.
- Students will be in the cafeteria until 7:05 or until max. capacity of the cafeteria is reached.
- At 7:05 the students will be released from the cafe and are expected to go directly to their first block class.
- Breakfast will not be available.
- All students arriving *after* 7:25 will enter through the main entrance (Steckevicz Lobby).

Class Change/Hallway Travel:

- Students will wear masks during all school transitions.
- Students are encouraged to walk on the right-hand side of the hallway.
- Stairways at the ends of the halls in the main building will be up/down but students will stay to the right-hand side of the staircases.
- The middle two staircases will be divided into one up and one down.
- Hallway student lockers will be closed.

**Bathrooms:**

- Students will use the single use bathrooms whenever possible.
- The large bathrooms in the hallway behind the cafeteria, near the library, near rooms 315/316, and near 217/218 will be closed.
- The large bathrooms near the Student Management Office (room 102) and in the math hallway will remain open.
- While utilizing a common bathroom, students should maintain social distancing, wear masks, and use proper hand washing techniques.

Water Fountains:

- The water bottle filling stations are operable.

Classrooms:

- All students ***must*** wear masks in the classroom except at designated mask break times.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.
- Desk areas will be sanitized after use.
- Additional wipes will be provided if a student wants to disinfect an individual seat.

Lunch:

- Students will wear a mask while up and out of their seat.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch.
- Lunch will have grab and go options--one area for hot lunch; one area for hot sandwiches; one area for cold sandwiches and salads.
- Vending machines will not be available.
- Students will adhere to marked directional arrows.
- Students may eat (while socially distancing) in the cafeteria and in designated classroom(s) on the 2nd and 3rd floors.
- Seniors may eat at the picnic tables.
- Sophomores and Juniors may eat on the stadium bleachers.
- The parking lot and student cars are off limits during the school day.

Dismissal:

- Students will exit the building through any exit door at dismissal time and should avoid congregating in groups.

Visitors:

- No drop-in visitors will be allowed to enter the building during the school day (7:00-2:15). Please make an appointment if you need to see school personnel.
- Approved visitors are expected to follow the same procedures as staff and students.

Failure to Comply with COVID Safety Protocols: *Including but not limited to the wearing of masks, observance of established traffic flow patterns, physical distancing, and personal sanitation protocols.*

- Students will receive a verbal warning when not in compliance.
- Students will be sent to the office for an administrative conversation.
- Students will be isolated and sent home.
- Willful or chronic failure to comply with mask-wearing or safety/distancing practices will result in the student being shifted to our full remote enrollment option.
